NOTIFICATION

With the recent directives from MoE on the preparedness of the "Conduct of High Stake Examinations" which is scheduled on 28th Feb. 2022 and with the increasing case of the Omicron virus in the high risk areas and red zones in the country, there is possibility of disruption to the Class X and XII examinations due to further outbreaks during the examination period. In order to prepare and ensure that all students are able to do their examinations with certainty and a high level of safety, the following are few reminders for the parents, stakeholders and general public to take into consideration with immediate effect.

- 1. Starting from 25th Feb. 2022, the school would be further imposing stricter protocols for the Self Containment mode of operation for the safe conduct of high-stake examinations.
- 2. As usual, visitors will NOT be entertained for any reasons unless deem necessary upon COVID-19 test.
- 3. No essential items both for staff and students (on campus) will be facilitated wef. 25th Feb. till the end of examinations for any reasons. Therefore, all are requested to refrain from dropping the parcel or visiting the school.
- 4. The management may allow the student mess items to be delivered near the gate site on every weekend following the SoP on delivery of items in Self Containment mode operation.
- 5. After the completion of the examination, all students shall be tested on 13th March 2022:
 - If everyone tests negative, local students from Drukjegang shall be allowed to go home in the afternoon (2:30 pm) and the remaining students on the next day ie. 14th March '22 (at 10 am).
 - If any student/staff tests positive during this time, or has tested positive during the examination, the staff/students shall be required to stay in the containment facility for a period determined by the Ministry of Health.
- 6. However, parents must come in person to pick up their child from the school, without which s/he will not be sent home. For further enquiry, you may contact Warden (17347870) & Matron (17366841).
