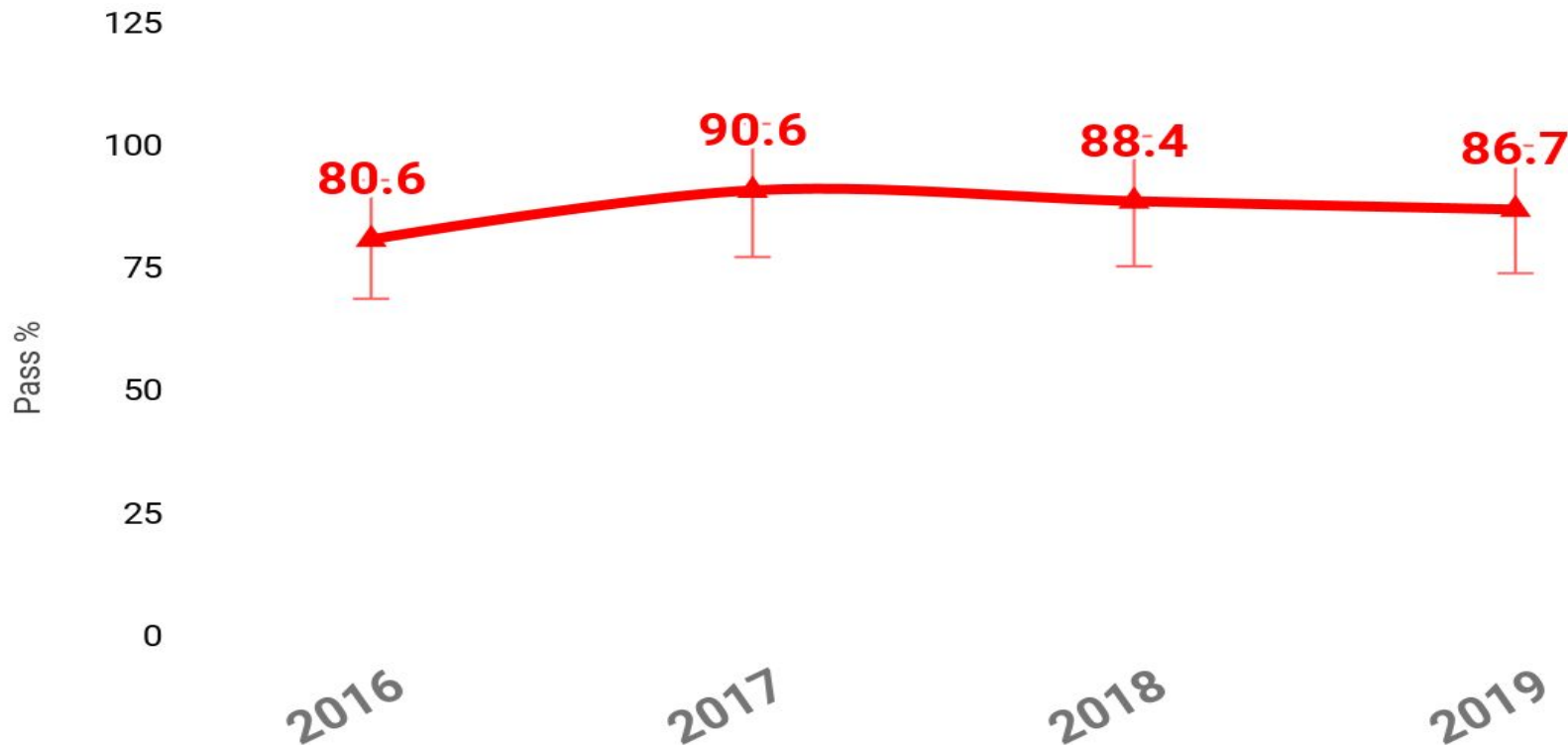

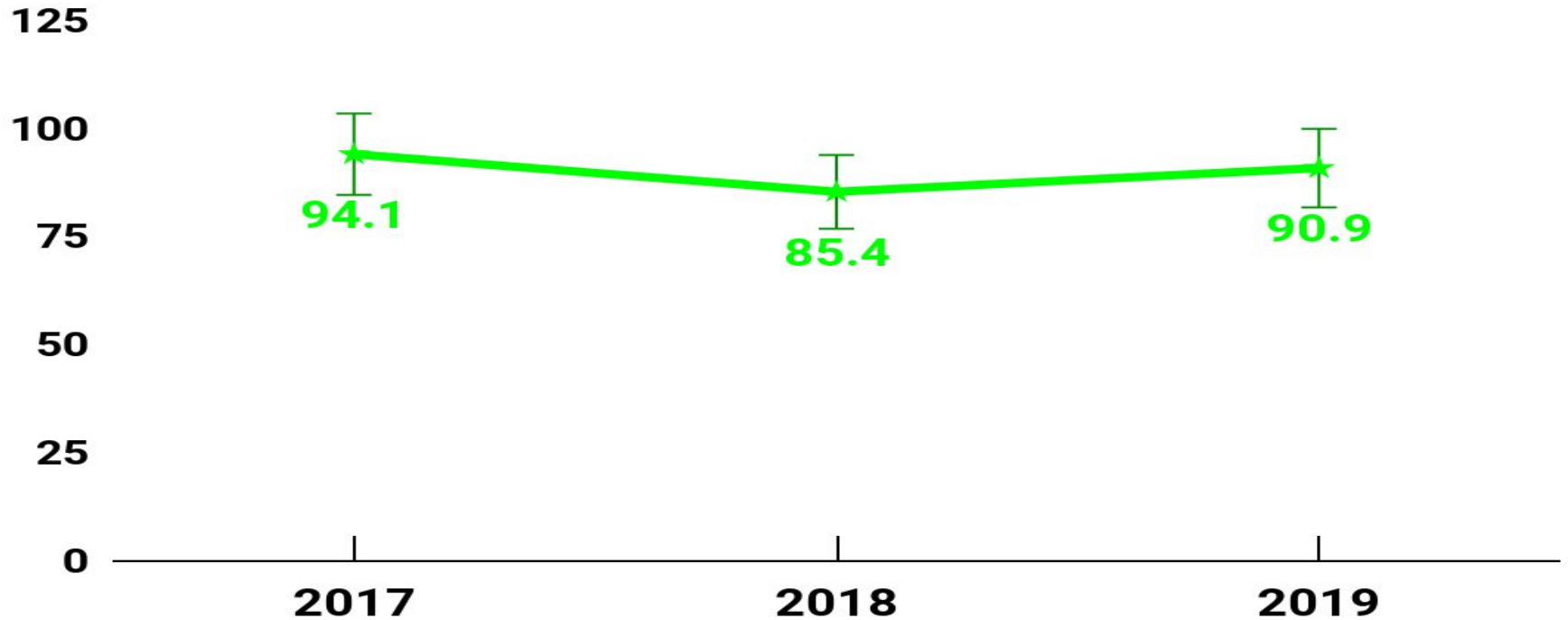

Class III Performance (2016-2019)

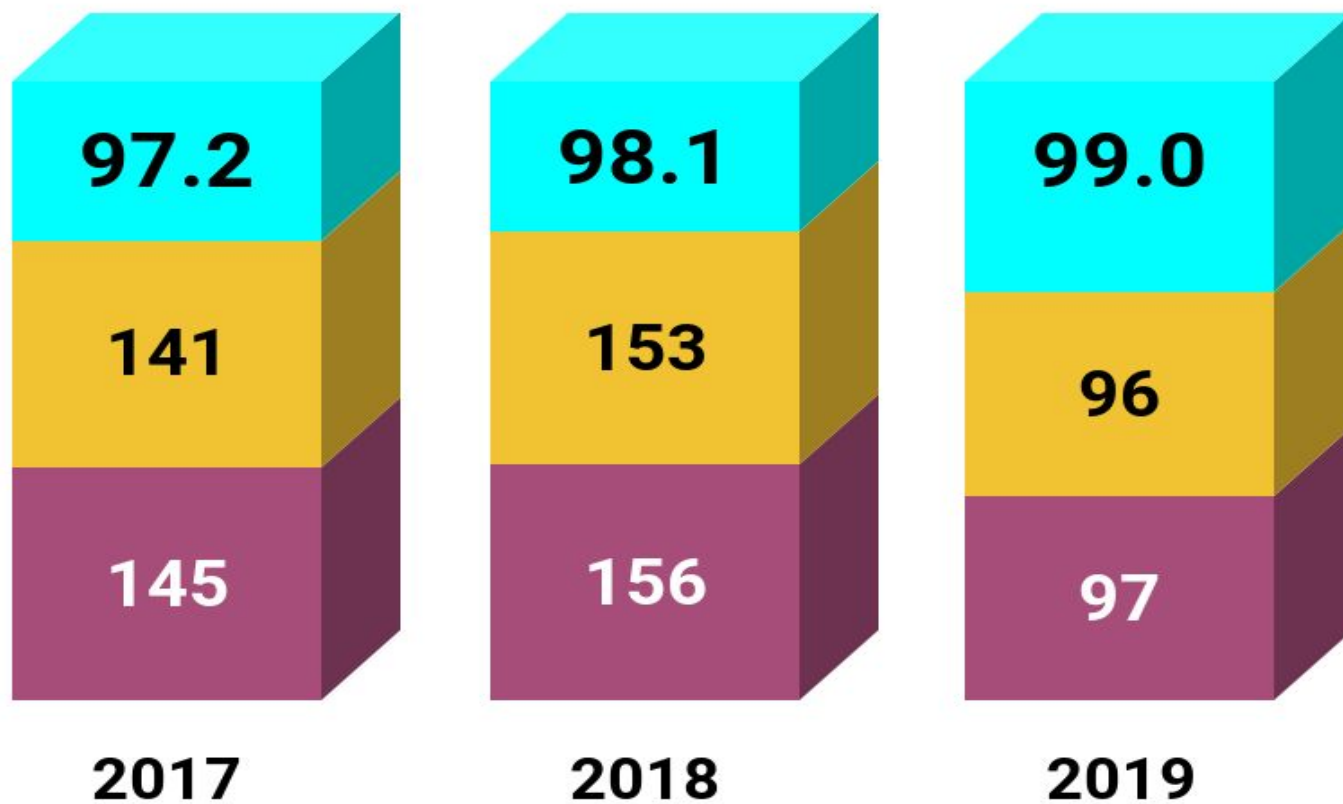

Class VI Performance (2017-2019)

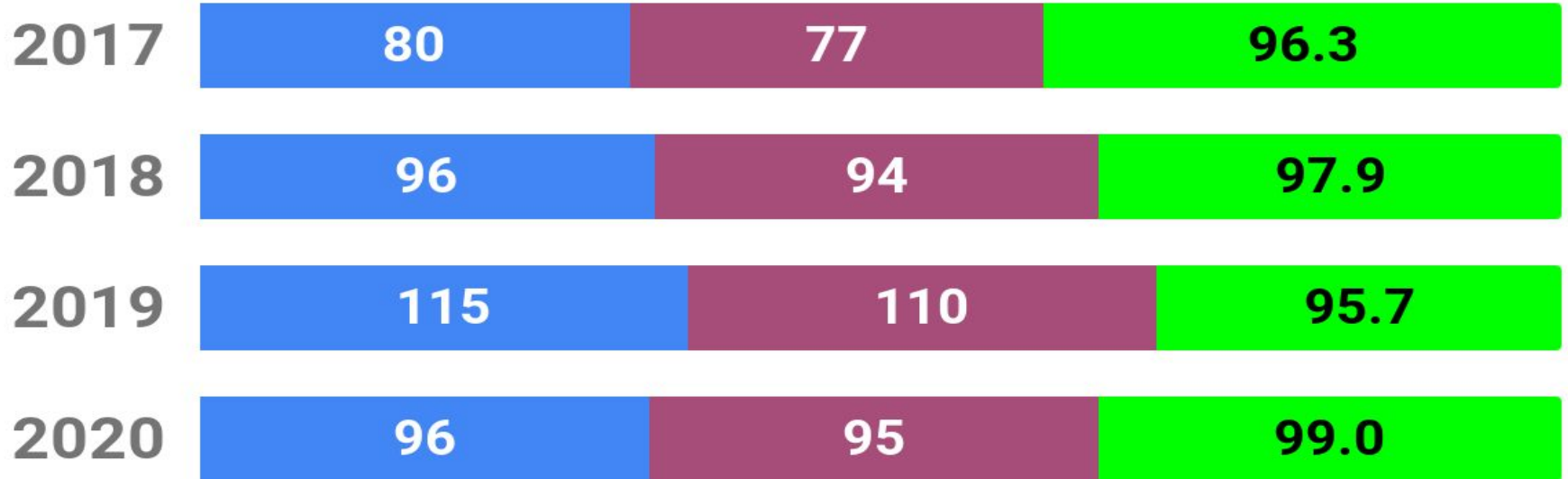


Cass X (BCSE) Performance 2017-2019



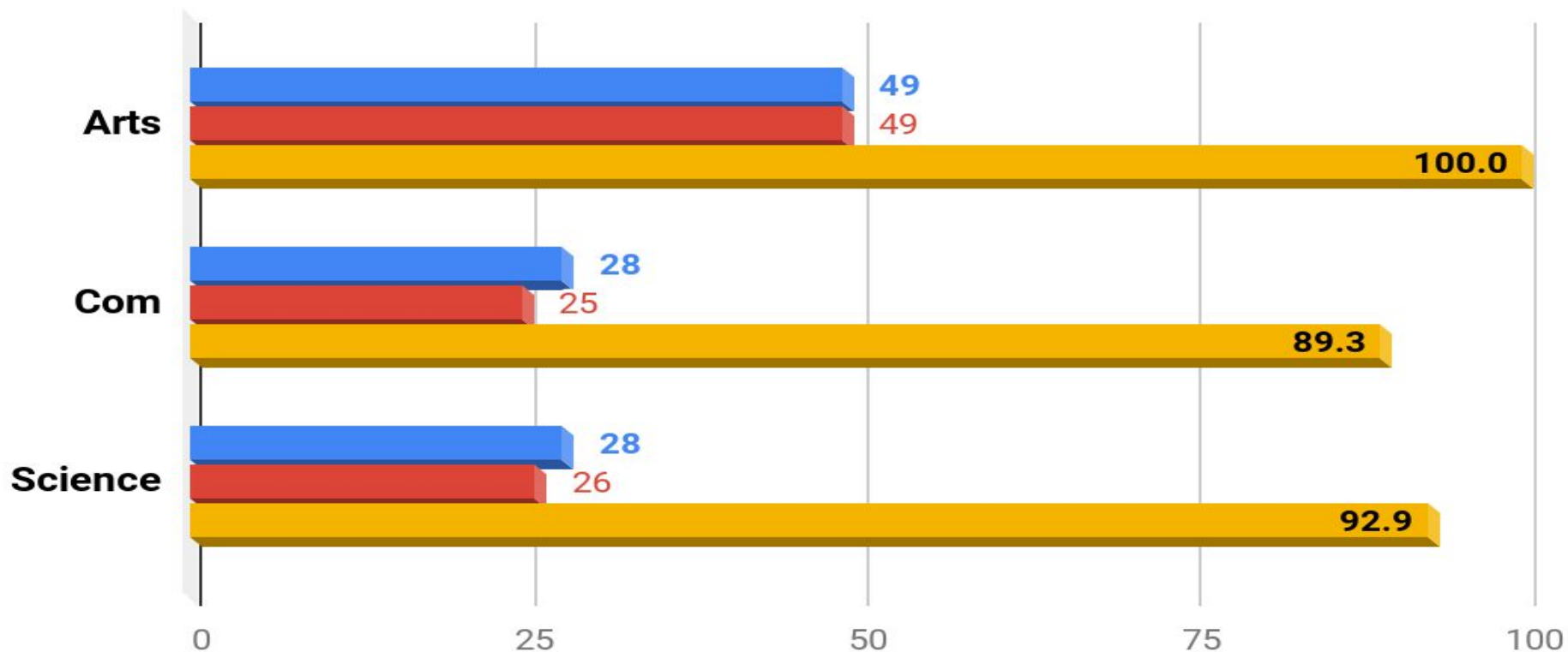
Class XII (BHSEC) Performance

■ Total ■ PCA ■ Pass%



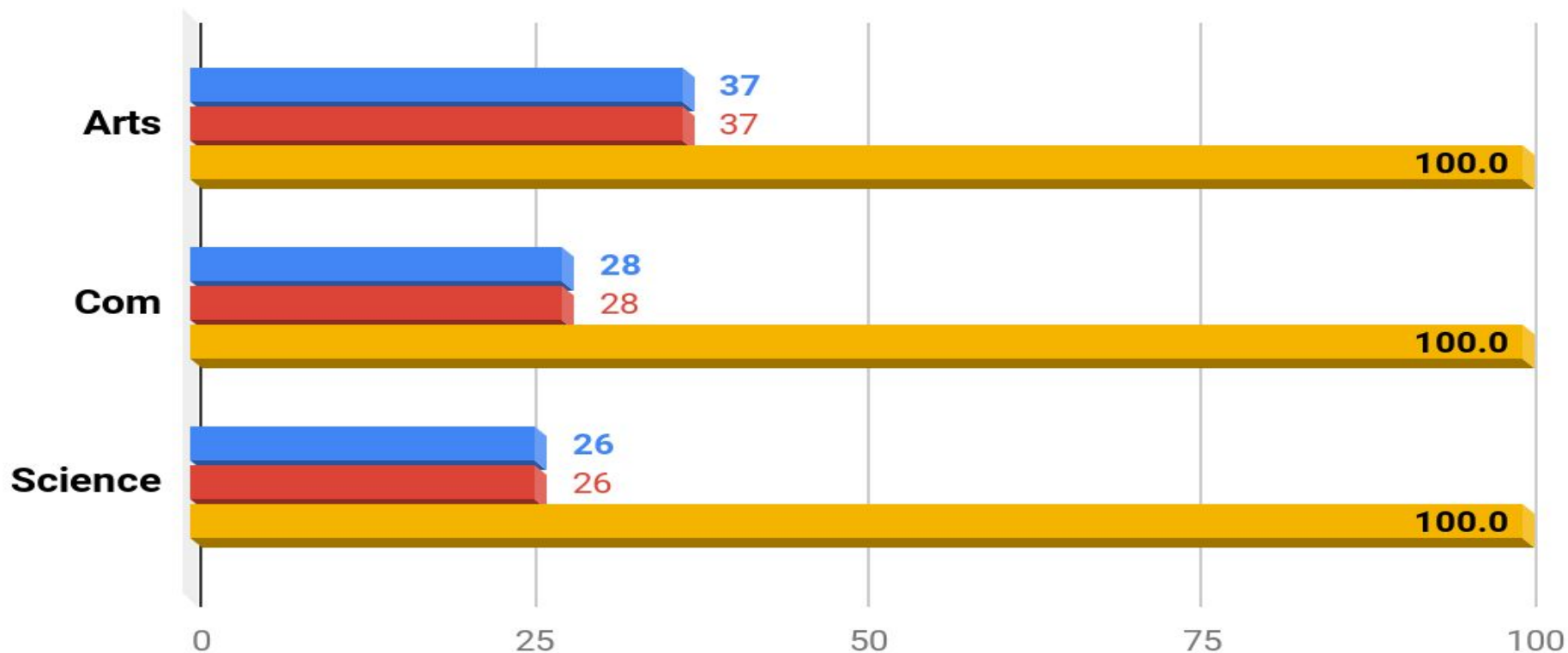
Class XII Performance Stream wise 2019

■ Total Appeared ■ PCA ■ Pass%

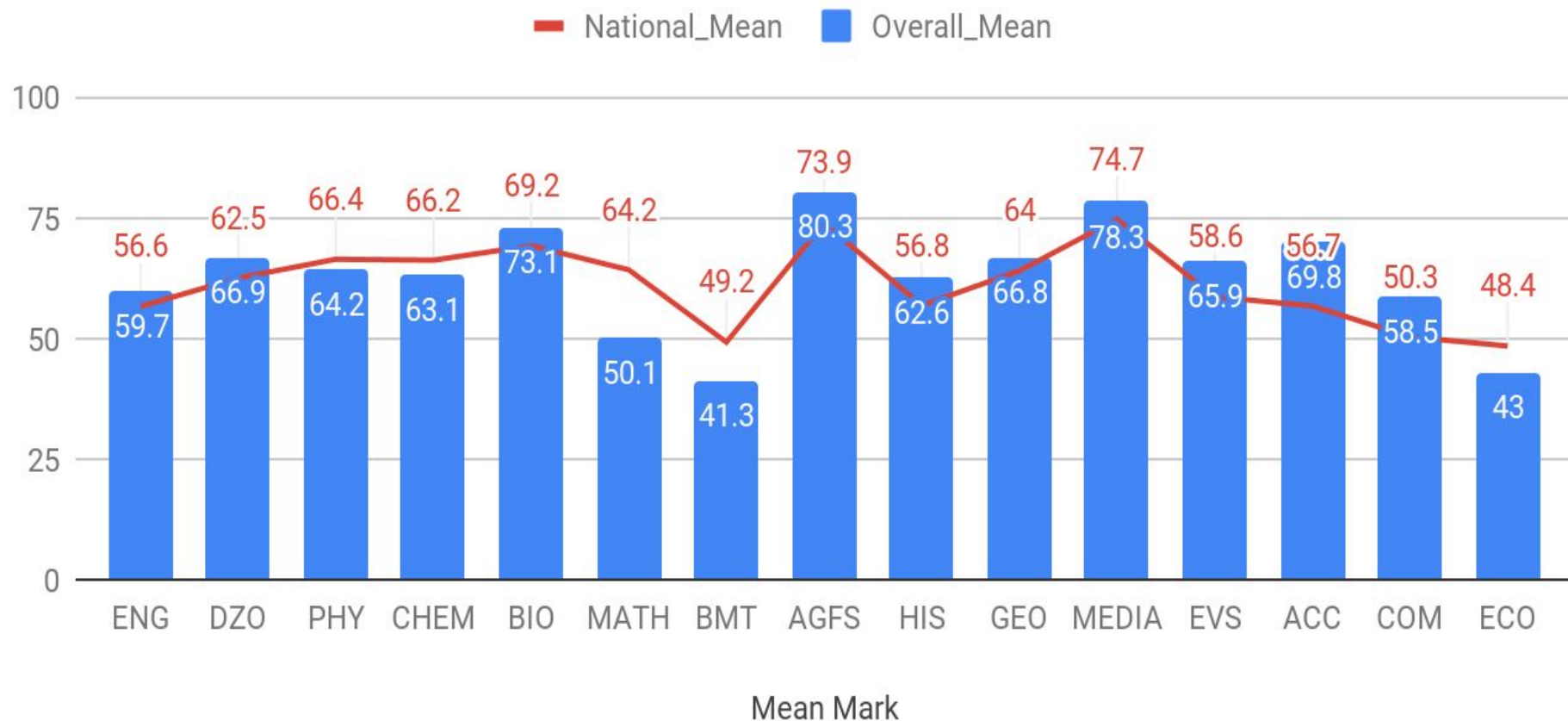


Class XII Performance Stream wise 2020

■ Total Appeared ■ PCA ■ Pass%



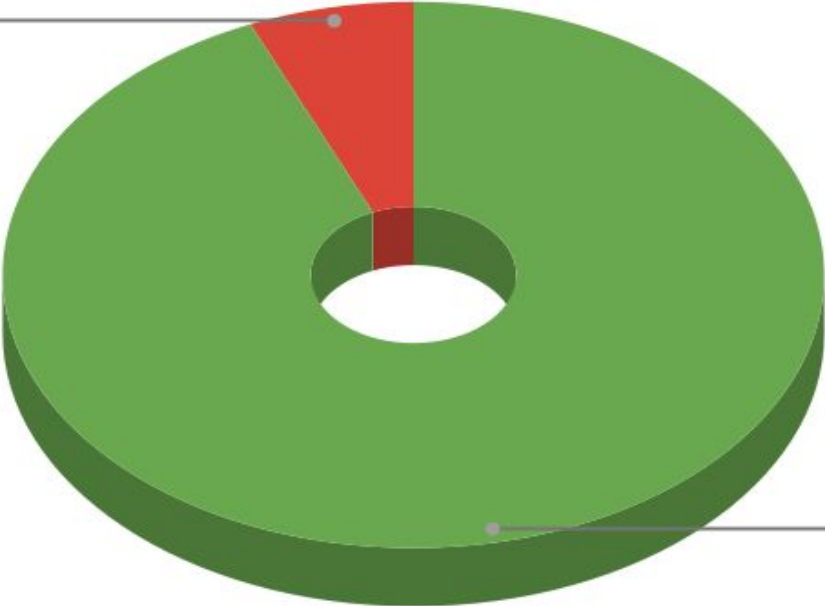
Overall_Mean and National_Mean
